The work meditates on several ideas, the crux of which is Eden: spirituality, environmentalism, and the relationships between men and women. Observing, often through the lens of a camera, our state in the world, the poems try to focus sharply on what often seems a blur. The poems are always attentive to artistic mediums and the craft behind them because our struggle is to make something perfect in the imperfect world in which we live, while acknowledging the impossibility of that quest. Gray's poems range all over, from adventures in Egyptian ruins with machine-gun-toting tourist police to the western edge of the foggy Irish coastline, and to the mythic past, where Adam and Eve visit a zoo and Eden has become a nature preserve. It includes the poems "The Snow Leopard"; "In the Metro"; "Toronto Zoo"; and "For Paul Strong". He pads on grassy banks behind a fence, with measured paces slow and tense. Beyond his cage his thoughts are sharp and white: he lives a compelled anchorite. A solid ghost gone blind with all the...
